Overview

JPS Health Network (JPS) is Tarrant County's public healthcare provider. It is tax-supported and includes John Peter Smith Hospital, JPS Surgical Center, a network of community health centers, and psychiatric services. JPS has approximately 7,200 employees.

Key Steps

1. Register on our vendor database:
jpshealthnet.org/vendors
2. Monitor JPS website for open RFPs/RFBs/RFQs:
jpshealthnet.org/vendors/open-rfprsrfbrfq
3. Look for formal solicitation email notifications (notification) through our vendor database system (B2G). Please note that vendor registration does not guarantee notifications. This is an added-value service that is based on specific commodity codes relevant to a solicitation. If your firm does not have a commodity code selected in the notification process or if your commodity code is not one of the codes selected, then you will not receive a notification.

5. Become familiar with JPS' basic solicitation and contract requirements by randomly selecting and reviewing an open RFP/RFB/RFQ.
6. Attend any JPS sponsored outreach events and visit JPS's display booth at outreach events sponsored by other organizations.
7. Be diligent and persistent in pursuing opportunities.
